This title was the theme of our annual networking conference that was held April 7th-10th. We hosted 75 women church leaders from Jordan, other Middle Eastern counties and North Africa. It was a time of learning, encouragement and refreshment.

We had two guest speakers, Dr. and Mrs. Juaneh who own "Better Business" company in Jordan which offers services in the area of training and development.

The first 3 days of the conference both speakers presented lectures on various subjects regarding planning and management. These included topics such as, empowering women to be responsible leaders, discovering your vision and setting your goals, making your ministry known through proposals in order to secure prayer and funding, how to build your team, crisis management and motivating others.

A discussion panel made up of four women who revealed their insights on how they took their visions and turned them into reality. They shared their struggles and triumphs as well as practical advice on building a ministry or company.

One of the highlights of the conference was hearing from the women regarding the volunteer work in their churches and communities. They shared from their hearts the regrets and praises of their work. As we prayed over each woman, our relationships and friendships were strengthened in a way that can only come from Christ's love.

At the end of the conference we had an evaluation session. The women had such a passion about the topics discussed and their joy was overflowing. Here is what a few of the women had to say:

The 2008 budget has been completed and AWT needs approximately \$262,000 to cover ministry expenses. The main categories of expenses are Media (airtime) \$63,000, Women's Development \$57,000, General Fund \$27,500 and Personnel \$71,500.
