"So they can be one" Iraq / April 20th-23rd

There is no doubt that the Christian work in Iraq is hard and sometimes dangerous. But, the believers in



Iraq say: "we are no longer afraid of the bombs and the violence, we walk with the Lord and He is our refuge and strength and He has called us to reach our people". What a testimony of God's working power through His Word and Spirit in the lives of believers in the midst of death and destruction.

Most of the Iraqi pastors are young in faith and they lack training. Yet, they love the Lord and want to serve him. Our team was privileged to walk along beside these pastors to equip and teach them to advance the Kingdom. The goal of the conference we held in N. Iraq was to help these pastors see that the Kingdom of God is not founded on the pastor or one single church. It was and still is founded on Christ and the gospel. Due to a lack of theological and leadership training, the churches in Iraq found themselves in competition with each other instead of being united in a common goal; which is reaching Iraq for Christ.

Ministries from Jordan, Lebanon, and other partners from USA have been working together closely to help these believers face the challenges they are facing. AWT was part of the team that conducted workshops for the Iraqi women. Ruba Abbassi, founder and director of AWT focused on "Delegation" as one of the essential tools for leadership that teach people to work in teams and practice UNITY. Gunilla Lindberg from Sweden and Basma Gammoh from AWT taught other topics such as "Being an influential woman", "Emotional relaxation" and "Active listening".

This was the first time these 26 women had the oppotunity to get such practical and spiritual teaching at the same time. They were filled with joy over the fact that people cared for them and took a step to be there with them face to face.

"Precious in His eyes!" Egypt / April 9th – 11th

It is a true joy for us to see our trainees learning and growing in their leadership roles. A group of our trainees in Egypt were encouraged and inspired to start a meeting for women in Moaatam, one of Cairo's suburbs. AWT responded to their request to teach and encourage women in their second annual retreat.

The theme of the retreat was "Precious in His eyes". With input of the 26 women in attendance, we developed a "problem tree analysis", digging deep for the root of problems, and then thinking about the fruits of the situation. One of the root problems for the women was not understanding and appreciating the way they were made as individuals. Another root problem discovered was family and relationship issues. Teaching from the Bible showed the role of the Holy Trinity in meeting our needs as women and helping us solve problems.

Special sessions were given on "Solving the People Puzzle". It was the first time for them to learn about different personality traits and how different personalities think and communicate. They learned that God has made us like pieces of a puzzle, in our different sizes and shapes, to come together for the glory of Jesus Christ. One of the women changed her mind regarding divorcing her husband after learning about this topic and counseling received from an AWT team member.

Women were truly inspired by the new things they learned and by the prayer times we had together.
