# "... For just such a time as this"

"Time" is a very important element in the Bible. God's word tells us: "For everything there is a season, a time for every activity under heaven." Ecc 3:1

God has a plan for all people so He provides cycles of life, each with its work for us to do.

Looking at the challenges women are facing in the MENA region, might seem to contradict with God's plan. However,

## **Ministry with McKinney Bible Church**

AWT had the privilege of ministering along side a special group of women of God in several areas of Jordan. The 6 women from McKinney Bible Church were a great blessing to the AWT staff, were they taught us about Crucial Conversations and Gospel Centered Life.

Next, the team headed for ministry in many Jordanian cities from the North to the South. They reached a total of 117 women and young girls in 5 Churches including a church with Iraqi refugees plus a special ministry in the Deaf centre.

The teaching impacted the lives of the women they reached as they taught about the value of the Word of God and how it is the light for our path daily, "Believe it, you are Beautiful!"- Valuable lessons learned from the story of Esther plus learning together on how God builds His Church.

Women were taught how to make a beautiful beaded heart as a handicraft. The spiritual message behind it grabbed the attention of the women. The craft was a beaded heart that had a big, clear bead that made the center of the heart that represents God, surrounded by colored beads in different shapes and sizes representing God's people. We are held together through His love regardless of our differences, and when we are united we reflect His love to everyone around us!



### "Jesus is the Balm of my soul" – Inner Healing Conference / Iraq

We were blessed again this year to hold a conference in Irbil - Iraq on inner healing, aiming to help women leaders and Pastors' wives learn how to overcome fear and trauma successfully. Forty-two Christian women leaders, from different Iraqi cities and evangelical denominations came together for 3 days and learned useful skills on how to overcome the pain cycle and how to help others who are suffering.

Our speaker, Rita El-Hajj, a Lebanese Christian counselor specializes in the area of trauma, is an Arab and is from an area that has been riddled with war, so she has a special understanding of trauma. She was able to relate to the women in a way most of us couldn't. AWT staff taught the daily devotional during the days of this conference.

During the sessions the women opened their hearts and expressed their pain and struggles. Step by step, they started to feel the hand of God touching their wounded hearts and start the healing process. "One to one" counseling was made by the speaker and the AWT staff. The women were so thirsty to receive new strategies and skills to help them be more influential in their personal lives and in their ministry. We saw many tears but we praise the Lord for the genuine smiles, joy and peace we experienced in the eyes of those amazing women later on.

A: "After the things I have learned through this conference, I will now have more patience and compassion with other women who could be hurting. I have learned how important it is to pray and bless one another."

B: "The teaching in this conference has made me realize how much our children need us and how much we should raise them in a healthy way so they will not suffer from the same problems we went through."

C: "I was touched the most by learning how to conduct a healthy conversation and I realized that I had a lot of wrong reactions that used to lead to arguments."

D: "It was very encouraging to me to realize my true value in God's eyes. And the teaching made me realize that I was totally ignorant in dealing with my brothers and sisters at church plus my husband and children."
