"Self Defense" Training - Jan. 2010

Out of our passion to minimize violence against women, in cooperation with the police department we held "Self Defense" training for 30 young ladies. These ladies were educated about risks they might face in the streets or parking lots, taxis or public transportation. They learned practical physical skills in order to be able to defend themselves. Our desire was to see those young women gain confidence in their abilities and not to be afraid if they were attacked by someone.





Most of the ladies did not know any of the information presented prior to attending this training. Below are a few responses we received from them:

- "This kind of training helps us to stay in shape, be healthy and safe!"
- "There is a great need among girls for such a training and we wish if you continue to train other groups of girls with it as well."
- "My dad dropped me off from the car one day and I had to walk a good distance to my school, I wasn't afraid at all to walk by myself because of the defense skills I learned through the training!"

The Lieutenant of the police department complimented this unique and pioneering idea of empowering young women. He was amazed at how well the AWT staff treated each other and the students in the class. He commented that he noticed something different about us. So this provided open doors to share what is different in our lives!
