

Over the last year, 278.000 Syrians have fled into Jordan to find shelter from the civil war which is raging in Syria. Half of them chose to move out of the refugee camps and live in the cities and villages of Jordan. AWT arranged two visits to minister to the families in the midst of their emotional and physical needs. In the first visit, hygiene packages and blankets were distributed in cooperation with two Evangelical churches in northen Jordan. We had a chance to do home visits to some families and pray for them.

They were sincere and touched of our care and love. In the second visit, we distributed heaters in the midst of snowy and cold days. The number of families that received help is 255 families.
